REGULATION ON REWARDS AND INCENTIVES OF THE AICAC

In order to create a system of moral and image encouragements for the most efficient arbitrators, official partners and employees of the AICAC, as well as be able to mark the achievements of persons distinguished in the areas of human rights advocacy, peacekeeping, international relations, as well as in other areas of socially useful activities, the American International Commercial Arbitration Court institutes rewards and incentives whose list, status, grounds and procedure of presentation are established by this Regulation.

1. General Provisions

- 1.1. The moral and image encouragements of the AICAC are rewards and incentives.
- 1.2. Rewards of the AICAC are officially instituted orders and medals of the AICAC. They are used according to the official mechanism established by this Regulation.
- 1.3. Orders and medals of the AICAC are insignia of a standard material form and symbolic content which appropriately characterizes the lawful owner of an order or a medal.
- 1.4. Incentives of the AICAC are symbolic documents whose content appropriately mentions the achievements and high status of the person thus encouraged and the attitude of the AICAC to the person.
- 1.5. The AICAC uses in its activity the following incentives: diplomas, incentive certificates and letter of appreciation.

2. Orders of the AICAC

- 2.1. Orders are the highest awards of the AICAC awarded to individuals who have consistently demonstrated an excellent content and quality of their professional and social activities with a sustained positive effect over a long time.
- 2.2. The Order of Justinian is awarded to the AICAC arbitrators by a joint decision of the Congress and the President of the AICAC for long and impeccable work in the sphere of administration of justice, promoting the international prestige of the AICAC.
- 2.3. The Order of Justice is awarded to the AICAC arbitrators by a joint decision of the Congress and the President of the AICAC for personal contribution to the multiple effective resolution of disputes, which led to the protection of rights and legitimate interests of parties to the dispute, as well as restoration of their legal status violated by the offense.
- 2.4. The Order of Themis is awarded to the AICAC arbitrators by a joint decision of the Congress and the President of the AICAC for personal contribution to the multiple effective resolution of disputes characterized by a special complexity of the matter of dispute and arbitral proceedings.
- 2.5. The Order of Honor is awarded by a decision of the President of the AICAC to employees and official partners of the AICAC for a conscientious work of many years in the sphere of legal entities' and individuals' rights and legitimate interests legal advocacy.
- 2.6. The Order of George Washington is awarded by a decision of the President of the AICAC to employees and official partners of the AICAC who made a personal contribution to organizational formation and development of the AICAC activities.

2.7. The Order of Esteem is awarded by a decision of the President of the AICAC to employees and official partners of the AICAC for effective work and high level of professionalism.

3. Medals of the AICAC

3.1. Medals are honorary awards of the AICAC awarded to persons whose activities are characterized by a high level of dedication, professionalism and public recognition.

3.2. The Medal "Experience and Wisdom" is awarded by a decision of the President of the AICAC on the proposal of the Secretariat of the AICAC to employees and official partners of the AICAC and other persons for their long and conscientious work in the AICAC or in cooperation with it.

3.3. The Medal "Effective Justice" is awarded by a decision of the President of the AICAC on the proposal of the Secretariat of the AICAC to employees and official partners of the AICAC and other persons for their deserved high reputation associated with their professional activity in the sphere of administration of justice.

3.4. The Medal "For Achievements" is awarded by a decision of the President of the AICAC on the proposal of the Secretariat of the AICAC to employees and official partners of the AICAC and other persons for their significant achievements in various spheres of professional activity contributing to the progress of human society.

3.5. The Medal "Supremacy of Law" is awarded by a decision of the President of the AICAC on the proposal of the Secretariat of the AICAC to employees and official partners of the AICAC and other persons for their efficient work in the sphere of establishing social justice, protection of democracy, civil rights and freedoms.

4. Incentives of the AICAC

4.1. Incentives are awarded by the President of the AICAC to individual persons who have demonstrated high professionalism and dedication in resolving specific issues of social importance, as well as on solemn occasions.

5. Special Provisions

5.1. Patterns of rewards and incentives are approved by the President of the AICAC.

5.2. Rewards and incentives shall be made by producers chosen by the AICAC on the basis of officially placed orders.

5.3. To any images and names of the rewards and incentives, the copyright of the AICAC shall apply.
